



## ADVERSE WEATHER POLICY

Beacon Offshore Ltd. acknowledges and accepts the risks involved in working during adverse weather.

The Company recognizes the absolute requirement for pre-agreed adverse weather criteria for when subsea work must be stopped until the weather conditions improve.

The pre-agreed weather criteria must be included in the Project Dive Plan so all parties are aware of the criteria.

The diving / ROV supervisor is legally responsible for operations and has the ultimate authority to suspend or abandon operations at his absolute discretion, subject to a range of criteria including weather, if he considers it unsafe to continue operations.

Any employee, contractor, or client has the right to use the "Stop Work Authority" if they deem it unsafe to continue the subsea operations.

The adverse weather criteria will include recognized guidelines issued by the International Marine Contractors Association, Classification Societies and other relevant bodies, in addition to vessel & equipment capabilities
